Section 504 WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Section 504 is:

A federal civil rights law that Prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in federally-assisted programs or activities. This includes public schools, colleges, trade schools or private schools that receive federal funding.

To be eligible:

a student must be
determined to: (1) have a
physical or mental
impairment that
substantially limits one or
more major life activities;
or (2) have a record of such
an impairment; or (3) be
regarded as having such an
impairment

504 plans include:

- Accommodations: Changes in the classroom - Extra time on tests, small group testing, sitting in the front of the classroom
- 2. Assistive Technology: Tools that help the student work around barriers calculators, graphic organizer, special keyboards
- 3. School Services: Related services that help the student gain access to general education speech therapy, occupational therapy, transportation
